

TOOLS REQUIRED


- Phillips screwdriver Socket wrench
- Panel removal tool/flat blade screwdriver

CAUTION! All accessories, switches, climate controls panels, and especially air bag indicator lights must be connected before cycling the ignition. Also, do not remove the factory radio with the key in the on position, or while the vehicle is running.


DASH DISASSEMBLY

- Unclip and remove the trim panel above the glove box and below the A/C control. (Figure A)
- 2. Pull down on the collar below the shifter knob and untwist the shifter knob to remove it.
- **3.** Unclip and remove the shifter trim panel. (Figure B)
- **4.** Unclip and remove the A/C control. (Figure C)
- **5.** Remove (4) 10mm bolts securing the radio. (Figure D)
- **6.** Remove the (4) Phillips screws securing the outer A/C vent trim panel to the factory radio and separate. (Figure E)




KIT ASSEMBLY

ISO DIN radio provision with pocket


- 1. Secure the *radio brackets* to the *radio housing* with (4) #8 3/8" Phillips screws provided. (Figure A)
- Attach the pocket to the bracket/radio housing assembly with the (4) #8 3/8" Phillips screws provided. (Figure B)
- **3.** Remove the metal DIN sleeve and trim ring from the aftermarket radio.
- **4.** Align the holes in the *radio brackets* with the holes in the radio and secure the brackets to the radio with the screws included with the radio. (Figure C)
- **5.** Attach the outer a/c vent trim panel to the *radio housing* using the factory hardware. (Figure D)
- **6.** Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra or AXXESS. Test the radio for proper operation.
- Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly.











KIT ASSEMBLY

ISO DDIN radio provision


- Secure the radio brackets to the radio housing with (4) #8 x 3/8" Phillips screws provided. (Figure A)
- 2. Slide the radio into the bracket/radio housing assembly and secure to the assembly using the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure B)
- Attach the outer A/C vent trim panel to the radio housing using the factory hardware. (Figure C)
- **4.** Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra or AXXESS. Test the radio for proper operation.
- 5 Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly.
